

DISCUSSION

- 1. As the CRO [Chief Reminding Officer], Pastor John reminds us these are not the worst of times, and this world is not our home. After 2020 and amidst the tumultuous start to 2021, in what ways did his reminders resituate your perspective?
- 2. **Read Matthew 16:13-20.** Since Jesus says this is His church, and He's going to build it, how can you personally participate more fully in building His Church with Him [both at your own campus and across lowa]?
- 3. In **John 1:14**, we read Jesus is FULL of both GRACE and TRUTH. Do you currently tend to lean into one of these more than the other? Why do you think this is?
- 4. Pastor John teaches that to be a No Matter follower, it's crucial to engage in these five NEXT STEPS: Attend Regularly, Serve Purposefully, Connect Relationally, Give Generously and Invite Boldly. Which of these five are you stronger in, and which do you need to grow in?

Where YOU'VE been

What YOU'VE done

What's been done to YOU
