## Introduction

In the fourth weekend of our June series Reach, Pastor John encourages us to make the invite. Our challenge this week is to invite someone into our lives through a simple activity such as dinner, a walk, fishing, etc.

#### Disgussion

1.	We are all planted where we are for a reason. Sometimes it's difficult to invite people into our lives, even - or maybe especially -
	when we've been planted in a place for a long time. What makes it difficult for you to invite others into your life?

2.	One thing that hinders people from inviting others is they don't think they have anything to give. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-8 and
	discuss ways you could give to others.

- 3. How do you think your gifts and talents could benefit others in their walk with God? Share with the people in your group.
- 4. Read 1 Peter 4:11. How can we use the gifts and talents we have to invite others into our lives and glorify God?

### Take Action

- 1. Make a list of people you should be invitational with. Pray about these individuals and invite one to an activity such as a meal, fishing, walking, game night, etc.
- 2. Reach out to one or more people from the list, and ask to join them in something they enjoy doing.
- 3. Learn more about that person as you spend time together. Invite them to church if they need an invitation.
