- 4. The story in Luke demonstrates that it's not where you are or what's happening to you; it's who is with you. Describe how in today's uncertainty you can walk with Jesus.

## Take Action

- 1. If you are struggling with unpredictability in your life, invite Jesus into that situation and ask Him to provide hope.
- 2. Share with someone who is struggling how Jesus has provided you hope in the past and will provide them hope, too.
- 3. Volunteer at one of our church partners to live out the hope we all have in Jesus.
