In April, we launched our campus vision to Cover the Valley by connecting 1500 people in 150 groups by 2025. We already have good momentum! In this season, we recruited nine group coaches, and our group numbers increased through spring. Attendance is growing, and several Sundays, we had 1100 people in the Worship Center. Good Friday and Easter were awesome, with over 2800 attending, a 31% increase over last year! We also hired two key staff members, Riley Shour (Early Childhood Coordinator) and Becky Nance (Elementary Coordinator) who invest in our youngest PLCers. We've also been blessed with a group of young professionals who are taking next steps, serving regularly, and finding community through their Monday night small group. 



We're seeing increased engagement in all environments at our campus. Attendance is up, and our Guest Services and Children's Ministry teams are almost full! Moms are connecting at our monthly Moms Meet group, and 20 people from our community are in GriefShare, receiving support and tools to help them walk through the grieving process. We had strong attendance numbers throughout the first four months of 2022, averaging around 850 people every Sunday for our online services, and people from most of our physical campuses are involved online, as well. We also connected many of our attendees to groups and/or online serving opportunities this year. People are actively reaching out and asking to step onto volunteer teams. Over 1100 people attended Easter services, nine people stepped over the Faith Line, and one attendee from California said Good Friday was the most powerful service he's ever experienced. Pray for the Online Campus to continue being a conduit for people to check out and get connected with PLC, either to a physical location or making our campus their church home.

Shifting back to one service in January created great momentum and community for us. We baptized a dozen people in January, many who were new to our campus in 2021 and crossed the Faith Line at Christmas. Many households are giving generously, and we're ahead of budget for this year. Over 50 people signed up for Bible Savvy, where they're learning the big picture of the biblical story and how to read and interpret the Bible more accurately. Mid, our Middle School Ministry, is growing with many new students attending. Three people crossed the Faith Line at Easter, one who'd been watching online for a year and attended in person for the first time on Easter.
