

FAQ for Student Ministry 2020/2021

When does Student Ministry resume?

Wednesday, September 9

What day/time does Student Ministry meet?

Wednesdays from 6-8PM. Our Student Ministry leaders huddle at 5:30. Please drop your student off no earlier than 6PM. We spend the first 15-30 minutes connecting around conversation, activities and food. This is intentional so students arrive between 6-6:15 get settled and ready for time shared as a group.

What are the names of our Student Ministry groups?

The Hub (6th-8th grade) & HouseGroups (9th-12th grade)

Where are Student Ministry groups meeting?

Currently, The Hub and HouseGroups meet at Twin Lakes Bible Camp and Prairie Lakes Church. We encourage students to connect with and attend the location closest to your home.

At Twin Lakes Bible Camp The Hub and HouseGroups meet in Harvest Hall. The address for TLBC is [7718 Twin Lakes Rd, Manson, IA 50563](https://www.twinlakesbiblecamp.com/).

At PLC The Hub meets in the Worship Center and HouseGroups in the Multipurpose Room. Both groups enter the campus through the office entrance doors on the west side of our building.

Does my child need to register to attend?

No. Registration is only required for Sunday morning worship services and Children's Ministry.

Will my student be required to wear a mask?

We are asking all students, volunteers and Student Ministry staff to bring a mask each week in the event social distancing is not an option.

What measures are you taking to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 at The Hub and HouseGroups?

Masks: See the previous question.

Cleanliness: We clean all meeting spaces and surfaces before and after gatherings.

Sanitizer: Hand sanitizer is available for use.

Social Distancing: We will do our best to encourage and practice social distancing. In the event we can't practice social distancing, we will ask our staff, volunteers and students to wear their mask.

Snacks: Volunteers serving PLC provided snacks will wear gloves and masks whether serving individually packaged snacks or popcorn/pizza.
